#### **TUCSON KINO SPECIFIC PARKING INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE WEEKEND of 11/9-11/10 and 11/16-11/17:**

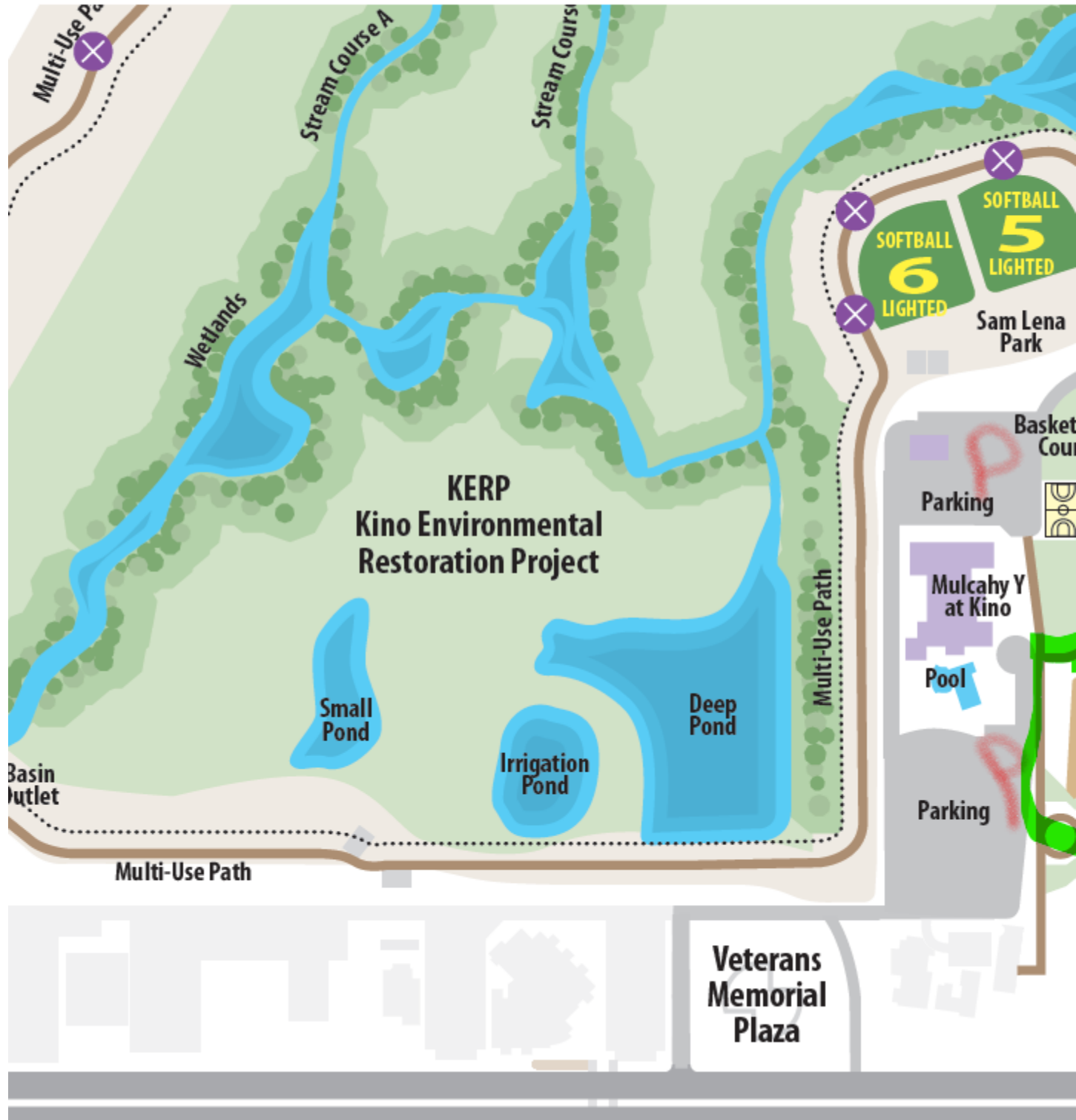
For both weekends ( November 9/10 and 16/17) players and spectators are to enter the complex (#1 and the Grandstand) from the main gate. Entrance onto the GS will be from the walkway between #1 and the GS.

Players and spectators should ALL park in the main parking lot...if they park in the North Clubhouse lot they will not be able to access the fields. The north gate to the complex and the GS east maintenance gate will be locked.

It should also be noted that on November 16<sup>th</sup> we have a walking event in Sam Lena Park (they will be on the softball fields and the KERP path) from 8 am until 2 pm. It will be shared parking in the main lot.

Please see Map below for parking and entrance to fields 1 and GS. Where the red "P" is marked is where you should park if you have a game at Field 1 or the Grandstand. The green highlighted path is where you should be walking to enter the fields.

Fields 11 and 12 are located south of Ajo Way. Map is located on the league web page or "[CLICK HERE](#)".



**KEY REMINDER: ADVANCED LEAGUES BLACKOUT AND PLAY DATES JANUARY - MARCH FOR AGES U12-U14**

- **DEADLINE TO ENTER BLACKOUT DATES IS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2019**
- For the January-March Play dates, a team gets one blackout weekend to select. As defined in the rules (section 2.17), this means that you can blackout a Friday, Saturday, and Sunday in one weekend.
  1. **You cannot select one of your blackout dates on one weekend and another blackout date on another weekend.**
  2. **IF you select blackout dates on multiple weekends, you will not be contacted to correct it. Whatever the first calendar date you select will be considered as the entire weekend.**
