Teams,

Thank you again for your patience in the moving of fields as we get closer to play dates due to COVID restrictions on field availability. I know that this year you have had to communicate to your teams/parents more than ever.

Here is where we are playing this weekend:

- NOS Santos (Friday, Saturday): ASA Staff will be on site. No Athletic Trainers. **Spectators continue to be allowed on the field following the ASA Spectator Seating layout and all must wear masks.**
 - Scottsdale Sports Complex (Friday - Sunday): ASA Staff and Athletic Trainers will be on site. **SPECIFIC SPECTATOR SEATING SEE BELOW.**
1. **PRIOR TO YOUR GAME, TEAMS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO WARM UP ON FIELD AREAS EARLIER THAN 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THEIR OFFICIAL GAME TIME EVEN IF THE FIELD IS VACANT.**
 2. **PRIOR TO YOUR GAME, SPECTATORS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO ENTER THE FIELD AREAS. SEE MAP POSTED ON OUR WEBSITE (or [CLICK HERE](#)) FOR A KINDERGARTEN ARTISTIC RENDITION OF WHERE SPECTATORS CAN BE PRIOR TO THE GAME IN A STAGING AREA.**
 3. **SPECTATOR SEATING ON THE FIELD IS ALLOWED ONLY AT THE OFFICIAL START TIME OF YOUR GAME AND NOT EARLIER. FOLLOW SPECTATOR SEATING LAYOUT (SEE BELOW)**
- Fear Farm (Saturday, Sunday): ASA Staff will be on site. No Athletic Trainers. **Spectators continue to be allowed on the field following the ASA Spectator Seating layout and all must wear masks.**

KEY REMINDER:

- **CONCUSSION PROTOCOL** - In the past weeks I have seen some instances where we all need to be better (more conservative) to protect our young players when it comes to head injuries. Coaches, it isn't only the referees that need to decide whether a player should be held out from play due to a head injury. You also have that key responsibility to err on the side of caution.
- **CONCUSSION POLICY** Coaches and Team/Club Officials please see your responsibility.
