To U14 and Under Teams:

Please make sure you my email on 11/17 that is also posted on our website about the Play Dates in January - March. To summarize based on some questions that people have asked me:

- U12-U14 teams do not need to "register for season 2". Your Spring games that were sitting on the 1/2/2021 date will be scheduled to the different play dates (see on the website) and around your blackout date.
- March 12-14 will only be a play date if there are rainouts.

- I have started to move games to the Play Dates. If you look at your schedule and see those games, those are **NOT FINAL** yet so please do not contact me.
- December 10 is the date I hope to get schedules to coaches for the 24 hour review for the games in January-March. This is contingent upon fields being allocated still and if there is a delay, you will be communicated to.

MUST DO ITEMS & Reminders:

- **SPECTATORS and MASKS: Coaches, Teams, Clubs you are responsible for this. MASKS are required for All Spectators at the fields as well as Coaches and their players on the bench. WITH RECENT EVENTS IF YOU DON'T WEAR A MASK, DON'T COME.**
- **TEAMS, I NEED YOU TO DO A BETTER JOB OF COACHES AND PLAYERS ON THE BENCH WEARING A MASK. PEOPLE AND MEDIA ARE WATCHING**

Here is where we are playing this weekend:

- Eagles Park (Saturday and Sunday): ASA Staff on site. No Athletic Trainers. **Spectators are not permitted on the field and must view the game from behind the fenced areas and all must wear a mask. Only**

players, Coaches, and Team Officials may be on the field. ALL SPECTATORS THAT ARE OUTSIDE THE FENCE PLEASE WEAR YOUR MASK.

- NOS Santos (Saturday): ASA Staff will be there. No Athletic Trainer. **Spectators continue to be allowed on the field following the ASA Spectator Seating layout and all must wear masks.**
