Application Process

Advanced Leagues is an application process as identified in the League Rules and is a combination of Automatic Qualifiers and Open Applicants. Web Page has the information on the Application process. 6/1/2020 marks the opening of the application process which will be done in GotSoccer. 6/8/2020 is the deadline to apply for Advanced Leagues.

Step 1: Apply for Advanced Leagues in GotSoccer using your Team account and naming convention that you plan on using for the 2020-2021 Season.

Step 2: Select the Preferred Division for your application. Should your division change in the acceptance process, it will be adjusted for you.

Step 3: Complete all details in the questions during the registration process for your application.

While you may enter your credit card information when applying, the actual Payment for the league will not take place unless a team is accepted and can be done later.

Keys to a good application:

- Adjust the GotSoccer Team account name prior to applying.
- The application questions are critical in terms of you providing details to consider for accepting your team. Failure to provide complete details can lead to the committee's inability to place your team properly.
