



Game Day – Management

The following are the required Game Day expectations:

1. Match balls are provided by the Home Team.
2. Home Team provides Official Game Card to referees at Game. Recommendation is that Away Team also prints a copy of the Official Game Card to bring to the game. **ANY TEAM THAT HAS MADE ROSTER CHANGES OR ADDED CLUB PASS PLAYERS SHOULD BE EXPECTED TO PRINT THE MOST CURRENT GAME CARD TO BRING TO THE GAME.**
3. Site Coordinators shall report game scores in a manner determined by the League Commissioner. In situations where no site director is available, the home team is required to report the scores in a manner determined by the League Commissioner (See Below). Official Score Cards must be submitted to the ASA office within 48 hours following the completion of each game.
4. It is expected that that the HOME team listed on the match schedule is to wear light/white color jerseys and socks. When there is a conflict in uniform color, the HOME team listed first on the APL schedule must change its jerseys and socks --refer to Team Uniform Policy (Appendix G – APL Rules).

GAME DAY - STANDARDS

The following are the minimum standards expected for Advanced League games.

1. Top Class Playing Fields: The playing field must be among the best fields in the geographic area and must be of regulation size according to US Youth recommendations. Turf or natural grass is acceptable. Central Locations selected and provided by Arizona Soccer Association. The League is not a “HOME” and “AWAY” based scheduled league. There is no expectation of “HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE”. “Home” and “Away” designation is solely used for designating jersey color.
2. No more than 2 games will be played on a given week unless special circumstances are required or requested.
3. Weekday games can be scheduled if fields are available and both teams have requested it.
4. Athletic Trainers may be assigned for games.
5. Referee Procedures: The League Assignor is expected to be diligent in attempting to obtain the best referee’s in the area. The League Assignor

- must provide the document, "Advanced League Referee Procedures," available on the ASA Advanced League webpage to all referees doing Advanced League games.
6. Video Filming and Photography – ALL filming and photography on the coach/player sideline must be approved by the League Commissioner.
 7. NO TOLERANCE for poor sideline behavior!

REPORTING SCORES

It is the Home team responsibility to scan and email the completed Game Card to advancedleagues@azyouthsoccer.org or deliver to the ASA Office no later than 48 hours after the completed game, or the game may be scored as a forfeit against the home team.
