2021-2022 Arizona Advanced Leagues Schedule - Coach Review

Coaches,

You are receiving this email so that you can review your schedule. There are 2 primary ways to review it. Games start after Labor Day with some playing weekdays (Sept 7-9) and others on opening weekend of September 10-12.

1. [CLICK HERE](#) for access to the public schedule.
2. Go to your GotSport account and click your team. Click the Schedule tab.

I will not be posting the link to the schedule on our Advanced Leagues web page until Friday morning 6 AM. At that time, schedules will be considered final for all dates in September.

In your review of the schedule, you will notice that I am still working on the U12 age groups and should get those completed by morning. All other age groups have been completed through September at minimum. I do not have the ability to suppress from seeing games that aren't final and are just placeholders.

If you see a date, time, and field for play dates in September, you should assume that is where you are playing.

For Ages U12-U14: The majority of teams will have 7 or 8 games scheduled between now and December 6 with the remaining 4 or 5 games pushed out to January 1, 2022. These games are in a holding pattern until fields are secured for the Spring (January - March). Roughly the first week of December you will be contacted to re-enter one new blackout weekend for the Spring and games that will be identified as "postponed" or "hidden" on January 1 will be placed on proper Location/Date/Time. "Postponed" or "hidden" on 1/1/2022 just means that they will be scheduled later.

For Ages U15 and older: You had all of your 10 games scheduled between now and the week before Thanksgiving. There are no games for you in the Spring unless games need to be rescheduled from the fall play dates due to Inclement Weather or COVID rescheduling for example. Some teams had some weekends with 2 games but you should not see them on the same day unless requested. Some teams requested weekday games but that isn't always possible if there aren't fields available or if other teams in your division also requested weekday games. **THERE ARE TEAMS THAT REQUESTED DOUBLE HEADERS.**

Out of State Teams had specific scheduling requests to help alleviate travel/hotel stays.

The following ages/divisions are completed (C) for their entire season at this time will other ages/divisions are In Process (I) with September being completed. U12 working on currently. Other ages/divisions will have the remainder of the season completed by Friday.

What you are reviewing....

- You should never have 3 games in a row in 3 consecutive game days unless you requested it. (For example a Game Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of the same weekend.).
- You should not have 2 games in one day unless your team has requested doubleheaders. If you did request doubleheaders, not all play dates could accommodate that request.
- Coach Conflicts: I look to avoid coach conflicts if you have 2 teams. If you have 3 or more teams or are not using the same coach account in GotSport or if you have not created your 2021-2022 ASA Player Official Registration (which is used for your roster), your coach conflicts were not avoided and will not be moved. The GotSport scheduling software does not take into consideration if there are multiple field locations that are not overlapped in time conflict and does not currently take into consideration traveling distance.
- As of today there are no games scheduled that conflict with your team's selected blackout date(s). Therefore there shouldn't be a request made after reviewing your schedule due to blackout conflict.

What to do if you find a mistake...

- Only you the coach may contact me if a mistake is found and needs to be corrected. Email communication is the only way to contact me to review the schedule. Scheduling is a manual process so it is possible a mistake was made.
 - a. Email Address is advancedleagues@azyouthsoccer.org
 - b. Email must contain existing Game #, Date, Team Name, and description of the issue to be resolved.
- Deadline to find any mistakes is 10:00 PM, Thursday, September 2. Final schedule is being released as soon as any valid change requests are fixed. Once schedules are final, requests to reschedule games will not be permitted unless under the reasons indicated in league rules.

In Summary:

- If you did not blackout the date and want a game moved due to tournament conflict, that is not an item that will be honored. Look to have your tournament schedule around your league game.
- A second notice will go out once October and subsequent months are completed. Divisions will be notified individually.
