Review Risk Management Committee meeting minutes from November 2018

Prior to the meeting Rick shared the meeting minutes from the previous committee meeting in November. Key points included:

- Background Check Compliance
- Medical Release Form Retention ASA does not have copies of signed medical release forms that the teams maintain.
- Providing coverage for ASA registered players in non ASA or US Youth sanctioned events.
- SafeSport processes.

General Discussion

There was some overall general discussion that touched on the following key points:

- Insurance Bid Harry provided a contact for ASA to reach out to obtain a competitive bid for the 2019-2020 season. The current ASA insurance provided, Pullen Insurance has been a strong supporter and provides outstanding service but getting a competitive bid is appropriate.
- Background Checks As ASA continues to develop relationships with other sports organizations we need to be mindful of their processes. While working with other organizations is important ASA wants to be mindful of ensuring its risk is managed appropriately while not creating extensive financial or administrative burdens for organizations or its membership
- Aspects of Risk Management Policies to be mindful of:
 - Travel
 - Weather
 - Mandatory Reporting requirements
