RATIONALE: Explain the rationale for your proposal and the intended effect of the change.

Rural Arizona teams have been subject to Stay and Play requirements as a condition of acceptance to ASA sanctioned tournaments. In some cases, these teams have been threatened with removal from the event less than a week prior to kick off. Stay and Play is a method for tournaments to bypass the budgeting of fees that rural teams charge their players and take money directly from the players themselves in the form of a room/night kickback from a booking company partnered with the event. This additional financial penalty serves as an additional barrier to the growth of the sport in Arizona.
