- 1. Effective January 28, 2017, any coach who is found to have played a player who is overage shall, at a minimum and after the appropriate D&R hearing, be suspended for six months. In addition, the team shall forfeit the game(s) in which that player has taken part.
- 2. Effectivve January 28, 2017, any coach who is found to have played a player who has not been registered with AYSA for the current seasonal year shall, at a minimum and after the appropriate D&R hearing, be suspended for the remainder of the seasonal year in which the player is found to have played and the following season year. In addition, the team shall forfeit the game(s) in which that player has taken part.
