**Discussion**: Discussion of what funds will be used for. Increasing expenses, ASA trailer, increased risk, increased work loads will be covered by additional funds as well as additional resources. Harry Demos believes this is a tax. Fee hasn't been raised since 2013. Tournament fee from 2013 have increased on average \$228. Out of state teams provide tournaments additional revenue which justifies the proposed fee. Corbett Hess finds the increase reasonable. Nick Markette asked about increasing expenses again — Rick Kelsey reiterated the reason for the financial need and added the Risk Management need as well. Derek Yen noted that the volume of teams participating since 2013 has increased real cost in staffing needs to manage. Joanna MacLean asked Derek Yen to specify the additional work for out of state teams. Derek outlined how all the work volume has increased and how out-of-state volume has increased by approx 2-3 times since the last change in the fee (2013). Rick Kelsey discussed the overall strategy for managing staffing resources.
