

BYLAW PROPOSAL

Section 8. The responsibilities of the Regional Directors of ASA shall include but not be limited to the following:

- (a) Direct the business of the Region;
- (b) Report in writing at each Board of Directors' meeting on the state of the Region;
- (c) Be present, where possible, at Annual General Meetings of the clubs/leagues within the Region;
- (d) Oversee and promote growth of the Region; and,
- (e) Perform other responsibilities as assigned by the Board of Directors or the President.

Section 8. Effective immediately, the responsibilities of the Regional Directors of ASA shall include but not be limited to the following:

- (a) Direct the business of the Region.

 Promote ASA and soccer in their Region.
- (b) Report in writing at each Board of Directors' meeting on the state of the Region. Represent the membership of their Region on matters of interest or concern.
- (c) Be present, where possible, at Annual General Meetings of the clubs/leagues within the Region.
 - Attend at least one (1) ASA event within their Region each year.
- (d) Oversee and promote growth of the Region; and,
 Be available to attend ASA events as needed (Presidents Cup, State Cup, Coaching Courses,
 Player Development Courses, etc.).
- (e) Perform other responsibilities as assigned by the Board of Directors or the President.

 Communicate with each club/league in your Region a minimum of one (1) time each year.

 Ensure clubs/leagues are up to date on AGM dates, Risk Management protocols, abuse prevention protocols and law, referee program updates, etc.
- (f) Be a club resource and connector to ASA. Bring concerns/issues to ASA Board meetings for discussion.

- (g) Connect clubs to important information provided by ASA as well as information within the Region.
- (h) Work with ASA to find and recruit new clubs within the Region. Aid ASA Staff in the new member affiliation process and onboarding.
- (i) Perform other responsibilities as assigned by the President and/or the Board of Directors.
