Section 4. This policy shall not apply to the extent that it conflicts with the following USOPC requirement in its NGB Athlete Safety Policy: "NGBs are committed to protecting opportunities for athletes participating in sport. NGBs will continue to collaborate with various stakeholders with oversight responsibilities, e.g., IOC, IPC, international federations, to ensure that women have a fair and safe competition environment consistent with Executive Order 14201 and the Ted Stevens Olympic & Amateur Sports Act, 36 U.S.C. § 22501, et. Seq."
