Section 1. The President of ASA, in conjunction with the CEO, shall supervise all activities of the ASA; the work of the Executive Board, the Board of Directors, and the General Assembly, and shall chair meetings of the same. The responsibilities of the President shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- (a) Administer the affairs of ASA with the concurrence of the Board of Directors.
- (b) Support the CEO and have knowledge of the CEO's oversight of office procedures and personnel, which responsibility may be delegated.
- (c) Establish ASA committees and make committee appointments as provided by Bylaws 501 and 503.
- (d) Act as representative with the CEO of the Arizona Soccer Association to USYS and USSF, which responsibility may be delegated, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.
- (e) Execute instruments for ASA that the Board of Directors authorizes to be executed; and,
- (f) Perform other responsibilities assigned by the Board of Directors.
